DAV Calderys Public School, Wankaner, Gujarat

We are delighted to announce the inauguration of a brand-new building for Calderys' second public school in Wankaner, India, underscoring our commitment to education and community development. Background

In 2020, Calderys, in partnership with the prestigious DAV College Managing Committee (DAV CMC), established its first public school in Wankaner, Gujarat, with the aim of providing high-quality education to local children. Recognizing the need for accessible education, Calderys took the initiative to address this gap in the community.

Inauguration ceremony

In September, Calderys celebrated the inauguration of the new school building in the presence of esteemed dignitaries including Shri Jitubhai Somani, Shri G.T. Pandya, Gujarat government officials, and Calderys executives including Michel Cornelissen, President and CEO, and Ish Mohan Garg, Senior Vice President, Asia Pacific region.

Key features

The new building boasts 13 classrooms catering to Nursery to Class 10 students, equipped with state-of-the-art facilities, such as science laboratories, IT centers and a playground. It is compliant with the standards set by the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE).



Community impact

Calderys' Wankaner DAV school is the second of its kind, following the successful establishment of the first school in Katni, Madhya Pradesh, in 1995. The initiative addresses the educational needs of the local community, reducing the necessity for parents to send their children to distant cities for schooling.

Enrollment growth

Since its inception in April 2020, the school has seen steady growth, with enrollment reaching 190 students this year. The objective is to accommodate 500 students by 2026, reflecting Calderys' dedication to providing quality education opportunities.
